**Re: Confirmed Seven COVID-19 Cases on Cowessess First Nation**

Hi, as of Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, there are seven confirmed COVID-19 cases on Cowessess First Nation within five homes. In respect of their privacy, the individual names will not be made public.

We need all to help minimize the risk:

1. No visiting; only people on housing allowed in that home;
2. Everyone must sanitize and wear a mask when entering Store One, Post Office, Golf Course, and Water Treatment Plant;
3. Make sure your color card system is visible.

Amungst the many worries, one worry is some are still visiting and some children are going to other homes. We need to stop all visiting amongst homes as well all guests must stay away. COVID-19 spreads through visiting and to get back to a safe community, we must sacrifice any visiting. Anyone visiting another home, we will be doing follow-ups. We must address this as a community and a lockdown will commence if all do not comply with above guidelines. We are seeking additional Front Line Safety Workers, please contact [careers@cowessessfn.com](mailto:careers@cowessessfn.com). Going to the public areas with a mask and sanitizing when entering is minimal risk at this time.
