- ✓ Committed to attending meetings, training sessions, hearing panels and other resolution processes;
- ✓ Required to sign Code of Conduct and Oath of Confidentiality;
- ✓ Submit CPIC with Vulnerable Sector Check
- ✓ Must be 18+ years old
